5 Scope of Services

- a) Project Development and Management:
- Assist in overall project management, including planning, budgeting, supervision, monitoring, evaluation, reporting, and coordination.
- Identify and prioritize projects, prepare cost estimates, and develop an implementation roadmap.
- Conduct feasibility studies, prepare detailed project reports, and manage the bid process for selecting implementing agencies.

b) Base Map and Topographic Survey:

• Create a geo-referenced base map suitable for local area and utilities planning.

- Perform detailed topographic surveys using total station and drone technology.
- Capture physical features, land use, infrastructure, and other relevant data.

c) Infrastructure Gap Assessment:

- Evaluate current and projected infrastructure needs over a 5-10 year horizon.
- Compare infrastructure requirements to existing levels and establish benchmarks.
- Identify gaps and propose strategies to bridge them.

d) Utilities and Facilities Planning:

- Propose spatial distribution, technology, and carrying capacity for utility networks.
- Develop smart strategies for water supply, wastewater management, waste management, energy conservation, etc.

e) Road and Landscape Planning:

- Design road layouts, cross sections, bridges, culverts, sewerage, water supply, parks, and drainage.
