Background/Scope of Work

Greater Noida Industrial Development Authority (GNIDA) is taking various efforts to encourage the citizens for decentralized waste processing. All the Bulk Waste Generators (BWG) in Greater Noida have been notified to segregate the waste and process the bio-degradable/wet waste within the premise. As a result, many BWGs have started processing waste in-house. From the experiences of several stakeholders involved, it is observed that not only the equipment / technology sellers are required to carry out the decentralised waste management but there are other agencies that are also involved. Since waste management is a specialized field, the experts in every aspect of the process are hard to find. Therefore, there was a constant demand from the citizens that such agencies shall be empanelled by GNIDA and categorized so that the citizens would have easier selection process and would get more value for money for the initiative they are taking. This EoI intends to shortlist and empanel various agencies for decentralized waste management from planning stage to the execution, operation and maintenance of the project. The list of such empanelled agencies will be made available in the public domain. Citizens will be advised to select the agencies from the list for their decentralized waste processing initiatives. However, it will not be binding on the citizens to choose from the GNIDA empanelled agencies only.

Note: The empanelment of agencies does not guarantee that the work will be allotted to them. It shall be sole prerogative of the citizens / communities whether to select the agencies from the empanelled list.

Request for Expression of Interest (EOI)

GNIDA invites Expression of Interest for "Selection and Empanelment of agencies for Decentralised Waste management for Bulk Waste Generators in Greater Noida"

Validity of EOI

The EoI shall be valid for a period of 60 days from the EoI due date. GNIDA reserves the right to reject any EoI which does not meet the requirement.

Empanelment Criteria

An applicant shall be considered eligible for empanelment if they fall in any of the below mentioned categories:

1. Seller/ manufacturer of machines / equipment required for decentralized waste processing

These agencies will be sellers/ manufacturers of the equipment required for decentralized waste processing of biodegradable/wet*waste of capacities ranging from 0.1 TPD to 10 TPD.

2. Service Providers for decentralized waste processing

a) Service providers with hand holding for the BWGs

These agencies will not only be supplying the equipment but will also do hand holding work for the citizens/ communities till they become self-sufficient to operate the machine/ equipment.

b) Turnkey service providers

These agencies shall not only be supplying the equipment, but also operate and maintain the same for the whole period for which they have been appointed.

3. End to End solution providers

These agencies will offer end to end solution or an integrated solution. This will involve collecting waste from the households, taking the waste to the facility, processing of the wet waste, incineration of sanitary waste, managing horticulture and dry waste and disposal of the rejects / inert. The main aspect of the work of these agencies will be this waste will not come in to the GNIDA's collection, transportation and processing channel.

4. Service Providers for other waste categories

These are authorized waste management agencies providing collection, processing and disposal services (as per applicable regulations) for different waste categories viz. Plastic waste, hazardous waste, e-waste, battery waste etc.

5. Experts in the field

a) Legal Experts

These agencies will provide guidance about the legal framework associated with the decentralized waste processing to citizens/ communities.

b) Environmental Experts

These agencies will provide guidance about environmental impact about the type of waste processing the citizens/ communities intend to choose. Additionally, they will also guide citizens/ communities on maintaining compliance with waste management regulations in force.

c) Decentralised Waste Processing

These agencies will be experts in offering guidance to the citizens / communities in selecting the best technology / machine / equipment to the citizens / communities based on the quantitative and qualitative analysis of their waste

d) Third party Auditors

These agencies will carry out audit of the waste processing carried out by the citizens / communities. The agencies will also certify that the initiatives taken by the generators are in accordance with the different statutory provisions by various authorities from time to time.

6. Community Awareness developers

These agencies will be members of the civil society who are keen on developing citizens' awareness about waste management by means of taking up cleanliness campaigns, performing street plays, organizing workshops for citizens.

7. Any other type

These agencies will not fit in the categories mentioned above but still want to get associated with GNIDA in the cause of increasing the compliance and efficiencies of Bulk Waste Generators for their decentralized waste processing.

Note:

- 1. Empanelled agencies will be responsible to send periodic reports to GNIDA in prescribed format.
- Empanelled agencies shall ensure compliance with all applicable Laws, including all rules and guidelines prescribed in the regard, from time to time by any statutory authorities concerned.
- 3. Authority reserves the right to remove the agency from Empanelment and forfeit its security fee in event of non-responsiveness, non-compliance or non-performance based on citizen feedback and surveys/audits carried out by Authority.

Brief description of the Selection Process

This EoI is a selection process for empanelment wherein the applicants have to submit a proposal mentioning following points.

- 1. Category in which the applicants intend to get empanelled.
- 2. Understanding the nature of work the applicants will have to carry out once the empanelled agencies get selected by the citizens / communities based on their category.
- 3. Details about the domain knowledge the applicants are having about the category of the empanelment. Providing evidence of experience of at least three years.
- 4. Approach & methodology including details of machines/ equipment and land requirements.
- 5. Information in the format prescribed in Annexures duly signed and stamped
