

**PRAGATI PORTAL (up to 29.01.2019)**

In Uttar Pradesh physical possession of Greater Noida Industrial Development Authority land, resumption of government land & handing over of land of Uttar Pradesh State Industrial Development Corporation is required. Ministry of Railway and Government of Uttar Pradesh need to expedite the same.

**(Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor)**

In this corridor, 8 villages of GNIDA are involved.

Total Land demanded by Ministry of Railway-34.1968 Hect.

Land handed over to the Ministry of Railway till now- 31.5107 Hect.

Remaining Area to be handed over- 2.6861 Hect.

Land Under Resumption Proposal at the Govt. Level- 3.1893 Hect. Request letters have been sent to the concerned departments. The proposal for exchange has been sent to District Collector and District Collector has also forwarded the proposal to Revenue Department of U.P. Govt.

Due to non cooperation of land holders. DFCCI has been requested to acquire an area of 2.6861 Hect. Village Hazratpur & Boraki.

Out of remaining area i.e. 2.6861 Hect. land, where existing abadi is proposed to be shifted and exchanged, efforts for land purchase are still continuing. Allocation for plots planning is also completed. Plot development work is in progress. Boraki 61 houses out of 150 and Rorthori 52 houses out of 190 shifted. After the shifting of the houses land will be handed over to Ministry of Railways.

**(Western Dedicated Freight Corridor)**


In this corridor, 6 villages of GNIDA are involved.

Total land demanded by Ministry of Railway-41.0614 Hect.

Land handed over to the Ministry of Railway up till now- 25.5808 Hect.

Village Makoda and Gulistanpur -15.2575 Hect. of land is to be transferred to the Ministry of Railways. In both these villages, acquisition formalities have been completed by GNIDA. But due to the agitation of the farmers and by raising unfair demands, the work have been come to a halt. After the intervention of Commissioner, Meerut and District Administration, DFCCI have agreed to pay difference amount. An amount of Rs. 20.05 Crore and Rs. 3.09 Crore respectively has been refunded to DFCCI by GNIDA. The refunded amount is being distributed among the farmers by DFCCIL and District Administration.
